#### How to apply for a rebate

## Step 1: Determine eligibility

Applicant: The applicant must be a CenterPoint Energy of Indiana, Inc. ("CenterPoint Energy") residential account holder at the time of product installation or service performed.

- Insulation is not eligible for rebates when installed in new construction.

Product: The product must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2025, and December 31, 2025.

Home's primary heat source must be fueled by CenterPoint Energy natural gas or electric.

# Step 2:

#### Complete application and attach certificate

Complete application: Unless noted otherwise, all fields must be completed on the application to receive a rebate. Incomplete applications will result in processing delays.

Sign application: The application must be signed in the space provided on page 2 of the application to receive a rebate. If Instant Discount is given by the contractor, contractor's signature is also required.

#### **Application and installation:**

The application must be postmarked within 60 days of product installation to be eligible for a rebate.

#### Attach invoice

Ensure that you have attached a copy of the contractor invoice to the rebate application.

The invoice should include:

- Address of installation
- Date of installation
- Square footage of installation
- Type of insulation
- Total installed cost of each qualifying service
- Instant rebate amount (if applicable) with line item detailing "CenterPoint **Energy Rebate Instant Discount"**

### Step 3: Submit paperwork

#### **Double-check information:**

Make sure the information listed on the application is correct and that you have provided all required information and documentation. Also, ensure that copies of all invoices have been included.

Submit application: Submit your completed application and a copy of the contractor invoice within 60 calendar days of product installation in one of the following ways:

To be eligible for insulation rebates, the primary heat source of the home must be one of the following:  CenterPoint Energy natural gas service utilizing a natural gas furnace or boiler  CenterPoint Energy electric service utilizing an electric resistance furnace  CenterPoint Energy electric service utilizing an electric heat pump with an electric furnace as backup								
Work must be completed by a program-approved contractor. Visit     CenterPointEnergy.com/SmartSavings for a list of participating contractors. All materials and work must be in compliance with local codes and performed per program standards.  New construction homes are not eligible. insulation rebates.
